Ms. Yomna Youssef Wins the 1st Place for Best Poster Award at the German-Arab Symposium on Bioinformatics



We are very excited to announce that Ms. Yomna Youssef won the 1st place for Best Poster Award at the German–Arab Symposium on Bioinformatics (GASB 2023) held on September 23rd – 25th at the German University in Cairo (GUC).

Ms. Yomna is a teaching assistant at NU School of Biotechnology and has participated with a project entitled "Single Cell Type Prediction through Machine Learning-based Models".

The symposium embraced the official inauguration of the German-Arab Research Network for Computational Life Science (GARN-CLS) funded by the DAAD and the German Federal Foreign Office that aims at fostering global research collaborations. Project partners include universities from Germany, Egypt, Lebanon, Morocco, Tunisia, and the EG-CompBio as a non-university partner.

The Pharmacogenomics and Personalized Medicine (OPPM) Program

On September 7th, 2023, the faculty at the School of Biotechnology at Nile University traveled to Germany to attend the 3rd all-partners meeting for the Pharmacogenomics and Personalized Medicine (OPPM) program held at the University of Kiel. During the meeting, the partnering universities summarized the latest updates on the progress of different work packages and outlined expectations of what is to be achieved in the upcoming period in the project.

The School of Biotechnology at Nile University gave a presentation on the progress of work package 3 in which they are the leading partner. Under the guidance of Nile University, the consortium partners successfully purchased and installed cutting-edge experimental setups that are to be used in teaching the OPPM diploma and master's program.



Net Mob 2023: Nile University Shines at the International Conference and Competition

We are proud to announce that Nile University successfully concluded its participation in the Net Mob 2023 International Conference and Competition held at Carlos III University in Madrid, Spain.

Our university presented three accepted research papers during the event. These papers included topics such as "Generating App Usage Data from Tax Data: The Artificial Data Approach - Analysis of French Data"; the second research focused on "Real-time Detection and Prediction of Social Disruptions and Disasters Using Mobile Data Movement"; while the third paper discussed "Predicting Societal Productivity Indicators Using Workforce Behavior Dynamics".

The conference and competition revolved around the general theme of understanding social challenges through the lens of mobile service usage. It explored how the spatial and temporal aspects of mobile app consumption are connected to major challenges faced by modern societies today and whether monitoring app usage and preserving privacy by mobile network operators help detect and address such problems when they arise.

The goal of the conference was to discuss ideas related to creating reliable artificial datasets for mobile phones. During the event, participants were encouraged to conduct innovative studies that explore the potential links between emerging data from mobile applications and society. They also discussed ideas related to developing models capable of reproducing private data from publicly available information, which can be used to create large volumes of high-quality artificial traffic patterns in different areas.

Furthermore, the conference addressed research on improving intelligent data-driven management of mobile networks, where solutions based on reliable data play an increasingly important role in the post-5G network environment.

The participating team from Nile University highlighted that the university's involvement in the conference sessions significantly showcased the research capabilities of Egyptian academics, particularly those from the College of Computers and Information Technology at the University of the Nile. It also emphasized the Egyptian role in scientific research in general.

Among the highlights of the practical sessions was learning the bioinformatics tools used in DNA barcoding for marine conservation and biodiversity.


